Common and Visual Standards

Common standards

- Set out, in detail, the expectations of the client
- These standards go beyond good practice
- They should always be considered as part of the planning process
- They should be referenced in key safety documentation



Key Points:

- Nominated person(s) to manage; store; issue and inspect lifting accessories
- Test certificates and records of inspection available
- Accessories must be individually identified
- Dedicated storage facility provided
