- Four key areas of change for consultation – ACOP
  - CDM co-ordinator/Principal Designer
  - Reg. 4/Appendix 4 requirements
  - domestic clients



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- other changes:
  - substantially simpler structure
  - Part 2 Part 3 falls out
  - PC PD symmetry
  - amended notification threshold
  - formal co-ordination threshold lowered
  - H&S plans on all projects

#### no changes in some areas



- PC, contractor duties largely unchanged
- designer duties largely unchanged
- technical 'nuts and bolts' requirements unchanged

- Guidance will replace ACOP
- Tailored towards needs of small businesses/sites
- Shorter than L144 (the current ACOP)
- Combination of HSE, Industry, and CITB authoring
- CONIAC steering group established
