



#### **HISTORY**

- Our existing systems were not robust enough
- Gaps arise in existing Principal Contractor systems as cards only go back to the Principal Contractor
- Breakdown in communicating incidents to the Health and Safety Department occurs
- The H&S Department are not always made fully aware of site issues
- Vision "we can't be everywhere at once"
- Managers feel more obligated to respond to raised written reports (as opposed to verbal communication alone)

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

#### The reports provide evidence of:

- What is or what is not happening
- The value/culture of H&S on a Project
- Worker participation (enthusiasm/'buying-in')
- Management ethos
- Existing standards
- Does the level of reporting match what you see?

## **WORKER INVOLVEMENT**

- Improved participation and building relationships
- Increased self-esteem, value and worth
- Encourage communication
- Increased operative reporting
- Enhancement of the existing 'Near Miss' Reporting system
- Pre-empt possible issues
- Negate re-occurring problem areas

#### COMMUNICATION

- Increase the core communication process






